

## **PURSUING JESUS**

Today we are in our third and final week emphasizing our 21 day fast in anticipation of our prophetic meetings on the 21<sup>st</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> of this month.

Today I want to talk to you about ... Pursuing Jesus

**Matthew 6:33** - Seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness and all these things shall be added to you... (NKJV)

**Q.** What does it mean when we say seek first?

**Q** what does it look like to God?

Matthew 6:1 – "Beware of practicing your righteousness before other people in order to be seen by them, for then you will have no reward from your Father who is in heaven. (ESV)

**Matthew 6:2** - <sup>2</sup> "**So when you give** to the needy, do not announce it with trumpets, as the hypocrites do in the synagogues and on the streets, to be honored by others... (ESV)

**Matthew 6:5 – <sup>5</sup> "And when you pray,** do not be like the hypocrites, for they love to pray standing in the synagogues and on the street corners to be seen by others. (ESV)

**Matthew 6:16 – <sup>16</sup> "When you fast,** do not look somber as the hypocrites do, for they disfigure their faces to show others they are fasting. (ESV)

## IT'S ALL ABOUT THE HEART

**Matthew 6:2-3** – So when you give to the needy, do not announce it with trumpets, as the hypocrites do in the synagogues and on the streets, to be honored by others... **But when you give,** give so that your giving may be in secret. And your Father who sees in secret will reward you. (ESV)

**Matthew 6:5-6 –** <sup>5</sup> And when you pray, do not be like the hypocrites, for they love to pray standing in the synagogues and on the street corners to be seen by others. **6When you pray,** go into your room and shut the door and pray... And your Father who sees in secret will reward you. (ESV)

**Matthew 6:16-17 -** <sup>16</sup>When you fast, do not look somber as the hypocrites do, for they disfigure their faces to show others they are fasting.... <sup>17</sup>**When you fast**, anoint your head and wash your face, <sup>18</sup> that your fasting may not be seen by others... And your Father who sees in secret will reward you. (ESV)

**Luke 18:10-14** Two men went to the Temple to pray. One was a Pharisee, and the other was a despised tax collector. <sup>11</sup> The Pharisee stood by himself and prayed this prayer: "I thank you, God, that I am not like other people—cheaters, sinners, adulterers. I'm certainly not like that tax collector! <sup>12</sup> I fast twice a week, and I give you a tenth of my income." <sup>13</sup> "But the tax collector stood at a distance and dared not even lift his eyes to heaven as he prayed. Instead, he beat his chest in sorrow, saying, "O God, be merciful to me, for I am a sinner." <sup>14</sup> I tell you, this sinner, not the Pharisee, returned home justified before God. For those who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted." (NLT)

TCC- It's all about the heart...

**Genesis 15:1** After these things the word of the LORD came to Abram in a vision, saying, "Do not be afraid, Abram. I am your shield, your exceedingly great reward." (NKJV)

## **OUR HEART SPEAKS**

Actions speak louder than words
Put your money where your mouth is
Talk is cheap

The heart speaks loud and clear by what we do?

<sup>2</sup> "So when you give... <sup>5</sup> "And when you pray... <sup>16</sup> "When you fast... these things practice out of a pure heart

These three are the staples of the kingdom, they should be a regular part of the Christian life. SOP of the kingdom.

In other words: Christians give, Christians pray and Christians fast.

Giving: Declares to the Lord... you are my supply? I trust you!!

Prayer: Declares to the Lord... I depend on you!!

Fasting: Declares before the Lord you are more important to me than life itself

Matthew 6:1... how to "practice your righteousness"...

**Ephesians 2:10 –** For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus **to do good** works, which God prepared in advance for us to do. (NIV)

Philippians 2:12-13 - continue to work out your salvation with fear and trembling, <sup>13</sup>for it is God who works in you to will and to act according to his purpose." (NIV)

## **GOD NOTICES OUR PURSUIT**

Acts 10:1-4 – "There was a certain man in Caesarea called Cornelius, a centurion of what was called the Italian regiment, <sup>2</sup> a devout man and one who feared God with all his household, who gave alms generously to the people, and prayed to God always. <sup>3</sup> About the ninth hour of the day he saw clearly in a vision an angel of God coming in and saying to him, "Cornelius!" ... <sup>4</sup>"Your prayers and your alms have come up for a memorial before God. (NKJV)

**Acts 2:5** – And there were dwelling in Jerusalem Jews, **devout men**, from every nation under heaven.

So how important is fasting, how important is giving and prayer for us?...
