

THE REVELATION

Good Morning TCC... Today we turn our attention toward the resurrection of Jesus Christ. The first aspect of the resurrection I want to discuss with you this morning is the revelation of Jesus Christ

Revelation 1:8,18 "I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End," says the Lord, "who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty...." ¹⁸ And when I saw Him, I fell at His feet as dead. But He laid **His right hand on me**, saying to me, "Do not be afraid; I am the First and the Last. I am He who lives, and was dead, and behold, I am alive forevermore. Amen. And I have the keys of Hades and of Death. (NKJV)

The word Revelation means: to unveil, to disclose, to uncover

Unveiling His Essence

Hebrews 12:2 – Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith. (KJV)

Unveiling His Presence

Hebrews 13:8 – Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever. (NIV)

Hebrews 13:5 - "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you." (NIV)

Psalm 46:1 – God is our refuge and strength, an **ever-present help** in trouble. (NIV)

Matthew 28:20 – I am with you always even to the end of the world (NIV)

Unveiling His Dominion

Revelation 1:18 – I am the First and the Last. I am He who lives, and was dead, and behold, I am alive forevermore. Amen. And I have the keys of Hades and of Death.

Colossians 2:15 – "Disarmed the powers and authorities; he made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them by the cross." (NIV)

(MSG) – He stripped the rulers and authorities of their power and made a public spectacle of them as he celebrated his victory...

Luke 10:19 – Behold I have given you authority over ... all the power of the enemy. Nothing by any means will harm you (BSB)

Acts 1:8 ... You shall receive power ... when? When the Holy Spirit come upon you and you will testify to everyone of me!! (GLS)

TCC- The unveiling of Jesus Christ ... in His essence, presence and His rulership means everything

Because He did you:

- You will lay hands on the sick and they shall recover
- Whoever sins you reemit they will receive forgiveness
- Where two or three of you are gathered there I am with you
- You will bear fruit and in this my father is glorified
- You are more than a conqueror in Christ
