

# WHY DO I STILL GET SICK?

We are presently in our fourth week of our healing series. Today we answer the question, "If it's God's will to heal me, why do I still get sick?

## **HEALING IS A WORK OF THE CROSS**

**Isaiah 53:4-5** – Surely He has **borne our griefs** (lit. our sicknesses, weaknesses, and distresses) and carried our sorrows and pains [of punishment], yet we [ignorantly] considered Him stricken, smitten, and afflicted by God... <sup>5</sup> But He was **wounded for our transgressions**, He was bruised for our guilt and iniquities; the chastisement [needful to obtain] peace and well-being **for us was upon Him**, and with the stripes [that wounded] Him **we are healed** and made whole. (AMP)

Isaiah 53:6... and the Lord has laid on him the iniquity of us all. (NIV)

**Matthew 8:16-17-** When evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were sick, <sup>17</sup>that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: "He Himself took our infirmities and bore our sicknesses." (NKJV)



### **BEFORE THE CROSS**

**Isaiah 53:5** – But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon him, **and by his wounds we are healed**. (NIV)

# **AFTER THE CROSS**

**1 Peter 2:24-** He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness; by his wounds **you have been healed**. (NIV)

**1 Corinthians 15:25 –** For he must reign until he has put all his enemies under his feet. <sup>26</sup>The last enemy to be destroyed is death. (NIV)

**Romans 7:17-25** ... I need something more ...the power of sin within me keeps sabotaging my best intentions, I obviously need help! ... Something has gone wrong deep within me and gets the better of me every time. <sup>21-23</sup> It happens so regularly that it's predictable. The moment I decide to do good, sin is there to trip me up. I truly delight in God's commands, but it's pretty obvious that not all of me joins in that delight. Parts of me covertly rebel, and just when I least expect it, they take charge. (MSG)

**1 Corinthians 15:42-45 –** So will it be with the resurrection of the dead. **The body that is sown is perishable, it is raised imperishable;** <sup>43</sup> it is sown in dishonor, it is raised in glory; it is sown in weakness, it is raised in power; <sup>44</sup> it is sown a natural body, it is raised a spiritual body. (NIV)

### WHAT HAPPENS IF I NEVER SEE MY HEALING IN THIS LIFE?

We do what believer's do

**Philippians 1:20-22**...so now also Christ will be magnified in my body, whether by life or by death. <sup>21</sup> For to me, to live is Christ, and to die is gain. (NKJV)
